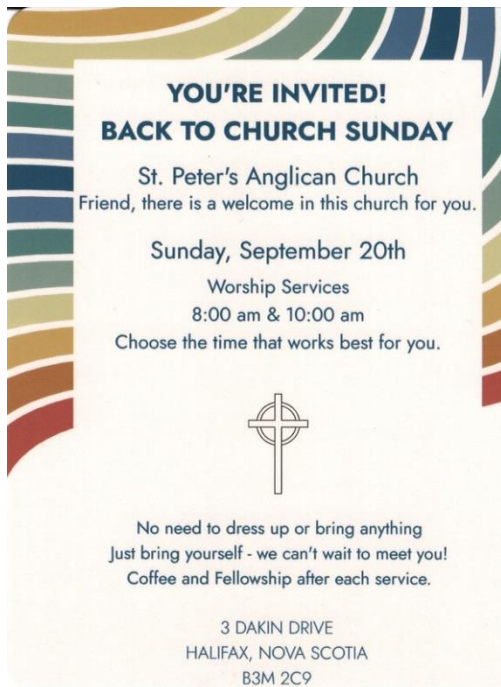

An Exciting, Meaningful Fall Season at Saint Peter's About to Begin

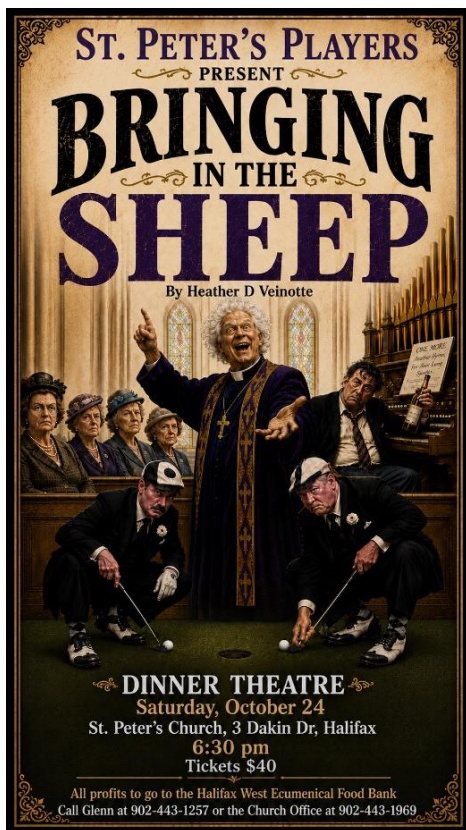

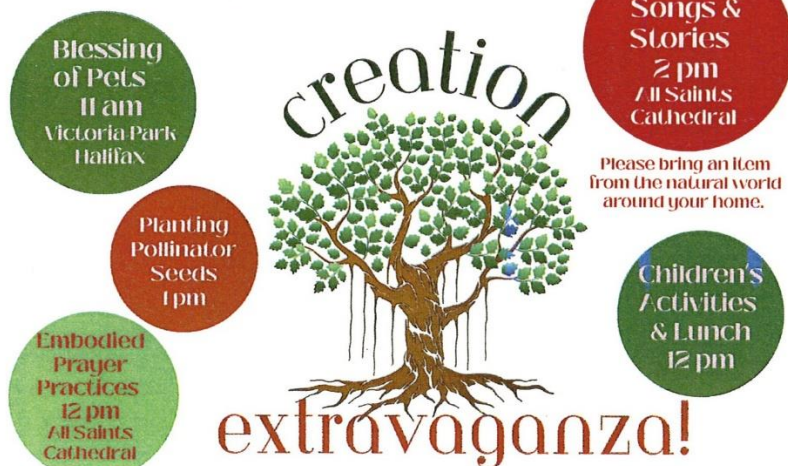
